

Wichita Workcamp is a yearly service camp sponsored by the Northside Church of Christ in Wichita, Kansas. We bring teenagers, college students, and adults together from multiple states to our city to scrape and paint homes for people in need. On average, we have **over 200 workers** during the week!



Wichita WorkCamp has been held annually since 2008 and is the first full week of June. The people we help live in or around the city of Wichita, and are physically and/or financially unable to paint their home. We also serve the city by painting various city parks and helping remove unsightly graffiti from city streets.



Last year we completely scraped and painted over **15 homes** in the Wichita area, repainted portions of a local **children's home**, removed what seemed to be **miles of graffiti**, and left a **lasting**

impact on the city. This year we look to do more of the same!

Every year, we seek out church groups, children's homes, and colleges who may be willing to partner with us in serving the city of Wichita.
